Okay folks and friends, time to make some notes and count some points! Here is a visual representation of the example we talked about on the podcast today, including the point schedule as described in this episode.

In our example on the podcast, the entry of German Wirehaired Pointers was shown in the judging schedule as follows: 4-4-1-2 ... This means there are four class males, four class females, one male champion and two female champions entered at the dog show. Our example assumes they all show up for competition.

WD (Winners Dog) = 3 points (a major)

WB (Winners Bitch) = 2 points

Example 1: WB is also BOW (Best of Winners) = 3 points (BOW earns the higher point count available between WD and WB).

Example 2: WB is BOW and BOS (Best of Opposite Sex) = 3 points (No additional points. WB/BOS with 6 animals in competition, is still only 2 points. A three point major in bitches requires 7 animals present, so the major comes from BOW over the WD.)

Example 3: WD is awarded BOS and WB is awarded BOB (Best of Breed) and BOW. WD/BOS = 4 points (5 total males in competition). WB/BOW/BOB = 4 points (By defeating WD for BOW she earns the higher point total).
